SOCCCD Family –

Thank you for participating in the recent vaccination survey sent out by the District. As we secure additional doses of the vaccine going forward, we will be prioritizing voluntary vaccinations in the following order:

- 1) Tier 1A: Critical and Healthcare Workers - Health Center employees, emergency medical services, police officers, people age 65 and older, giving priority to those who are most vulnerable and with chronic health conditions. Those “persons at risk for exposure to SARS-CoV-2 through their work in any role in direct health care or long-term care settings... and includes persons at direct risk of exposure in their non-clinical roles, such as, but not limited to, environmental services, patient transport, or interpretation” (Vaccine clinic volunteers, or individuals per OCHCA).
- 2) Tier 1B: Education and Childcare – individuals in direct contact with students and children, Food and agriculture workers – anticipated vaccines February per OCHCA
- 3) Tier 1C: All Other employees of the District per OCHCA guidelines and vaccine availability.

**\*SOCCCD and Colleges are in alignment with local OCHCA and distribution may change upon County recommendations and vaccine availability.**

If you are eligible to receive a District vaccination, you will be notified through your District email with additional information on how to sign up and get a date/time for a vaccine as they become available. You may be required to respond within 24 hours.

Due to the fact that we still do not know how many vaccinations will become immediately available to the District, we still want to encourage employees who are 65 and over to continue with any other efforts through your individual counties.
