Greetings Staff and Faculty:

In a message sent on [May 1, 2020](#), I communicated to you that we are continuing the process of following State and County [guidelines](#) to reopen our communities. Simultaneously I shared that our tele-learning and tele-working status would continue through the end of May, or until the Governor lifts the State "stay-at-home" orders.

Given that Orange County is just approaching the reopening process with a deeper transition into Stage 2 of the Resilience Roadmap, and with the announcements that Irvine Valley College and Saddleback College will conduct the Summer Sessions online, this email serves as notification that we will continue to telework throughout the summer, which officially concludes for SOCCCD on **August 7, 2020**.

As we continue to promote working from home as much as possible, we will also encourage that you adhere to strict social distancing and precautionary methods if you have been identified by your supervisor to work at any District location to carry-out the essential functions of your job. Additionally, it is required that all residents and visitors in Orange County wear [cloth face-coverings/masks](#) in public.

Please consult with your supervisors to ensure that we continue to support our students in the many ways that define the work we do for their success. Based on data and recommendations available from health experts as we approach the fall semester, I will provide an update regarding the District's tele-learning and tele-working status at the beginning of August.

Please remain healthy and contribute to the health of the community by staying home. We will see you all soon in person or on camera!
