



Notice of Public Hearing to Solicit Input Regarding the Composition of Trustee Areas

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Elections Code section 10010(a)(2), as part of its process of transitioning to a by-trustee area elections system, the Board of Trustees of the South Orange County Community College District (“SOCCCD” or “District”) will hold a Public Hearing via Zoom Teleconference and in the Ronald Reagan Board of Trustees Room (Room 145, Health Sciences/District Offices Building of Saddleback College), 28000 Marguerite Parkway, Mission Viejo, CA 92692, on **January 24, 2022 at or around 6:30 PM**, to receive community comments and public testimony concerning the draft maps prepared by the District’s demographer and the proposed sequence of elections, if applicable.

Public Hearing Subject: Pursuant to Election Code Section 10010(a)(2), before a political subdivision that is changing from an at-large election system to a by-trustee-area elections system adopts a map of the boundaries of the trustees areas, the political subdivision must hold public hearings at which the public is invited to provide input regarding the content of the draft map or maps and the proposed sequence of elections, if applicable.

In an effort to control the spread of COVID-19, this meeting will not be physically open to the public. All members of the public may participate in the meeting via Zoom videoconference. Upon entry into the meeting, all computers and telephones except for the Board of Trustees shall be muted. The January 24, 2022 Board Meeting will be conducted via Zoom videoconference.

In compliance with AB 361 and Executive Orders N-15-21, and N-1-22, Board Members, interested parties, and members of the public will be able to call or sign-in to the meeting at or around 6:30 p.m. on Monday, January 24, 2022.

All public records related to an open session item on the agenda, which are not exempt from disclosure pursuant to the California Public Records Act, that are distributed to a majority of the legislative body will be available for public inspection at the SOCCCD website at www.socccd.edu, at the same time that the public records are distributed or made available to a majority of the members of the legislative body. All supporting documentation is available for public review.

If you challenge this issue in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Trustees at, or prior to, the public hearing.
