

DISTRICT-WIDE PLANNING COUNCIL (DWPC)

Purpose of the Committee:

The purpose of the District-wide Planning Council is to coordinate all district-wide planning. DWPC addresses issues related to the implementation, assessment, evaluation, and prioritization of essential planning elements which include educational and resources planning.

DWPC is responsible for the discussion, approval and adoption of the components of the District-wide Strategic Plan. The council monitors district-wide planning timelines, reviews progress on objectives and key performance indicators and conducts regular evaluation of the strategic plan. DWPC also reviews and updates major planning documents such as the District-wide Planning and Decision Making Manual and District-wide Function Map.
