

## Irvine Valley College's 2020 Professor of the Year Leonard Lamp

WHEREAS, Leonard Lamp has five years of mathematics teaching experience at several institutions at both the university and community college levels; and

HEREAS, Leonard Lamp received his Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts in mathematics at California State University, San Bernardino, where he graduated Summa Cum Laude and with departmental honors. While enrolled in his MA program, he taught two years at CSUSB and was involved in the development of remedial math courses; and

WHEREAS, Leonard Lamp was an instructor and tutor for the Intensive Math Program and Early Start Math Program. During his time with the program, students passed both the beginning algebra and intermediate algebra courses at an 80% pass rate. He was named Graduate Student of the Year and received an Outstanding Thesis Award; and

HEREAS, while Leonard Lamp was a temporary full-time instructor in the mathematics department at San Bernardino Valley College, he was involved in the development of a non-credit pathway to increase students' probability of completing their transferable math requirement in the first year of college; and

WHEREAS, since graduating, Leonard Lamp has continued to research with faculty at CSUSB, and has written a paper that is scheduled to be published soon with the Mathematics Association of America. This paper includes an original theorem and proof; now, therefore,
