

DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND/OR PETS ON DISTRICT PREMISES

Domestic animals and/or pets of any kind are not allowed on District premises, except as described herein. This restriction also applies to domestic animals and/or pets confined in any vehicle parked within a college boundary.

In connection with class assignments and/or special events, a college president or designee may grant approval for domestic animals and/or pets to be permitted on District premises. When such approval is granted, the owner/handler shall:

1. Manage, control, and be responsible for the domestic animal(s) and/or pet(s) at all times while on District premises;
2. Ensure that the domestic animal(s) and/or pet(s) meet state requirements and county ordinances; and
3. Clean up after the domestic animal(s) and/or pet(s).

This policy does not apply to the use of service animals as promulgated in Board Policy and Administrative Regulation 3440 *Service Animals*, or to the instructional use of animals or animals indigenous to the grounds.
