

STUDENT FEES

Students shall be assessed an enrollment fee, health fee, and student representation fee at the time of enrollment. Students may also be charged instructional materials fees, parking fee, associated students fee, nonresident application fee, and other fees as permitted by law or regulation. The amounts of the fees are established and/or permitted by law. The District may adjust, waive, or partially refund the fee as provided in the law or regulation.

Students shall receive up to two copies of their transcripts and verifications of records without charge.

All student fees charged shall be published in the college catalogs. They may also be provided in other print and electronic publications.

The District shall refund student fees in accordance with applicable federal and state laws and regulations and District policies and regulations.

The Chancellor shall establish regulations defining the fees charged and refund process.
