

ASSOCIATED STUDENTS' ELECTIONS

The Associated Students' organization at each college shall conduct annual elections to elect officers. The elections shall be conducted in accordance with procedures established by the Associated Students' organization subject to the approval of the college president or designee in consultation with the Vice President for Student Services.

Any student elected as an officer in the Associated Students' organization shall meet the following requirements:

- The student shall be enrolled in the District at the time of election and throughout their term of office, with the minimum required number of units or the equivalent, as required by each college, but not fewer than five (5) semester units.
- The student shall meet and maintain the minimum standards of scholarship established and published in the college catalog and the Associated Students' organization election packet.
- The student shall meet the requirements specified in the constitution and bylaws of the respective college's Associated Students' organization.
