a. COURSE CHANGES AND ADDITIONS

BUSINESS MANAGER'S REPORT

a. PERMANENT CAMPUS

Change Order No. 1 -- Sully-Miller Contracting Company has requested a five-day extension for portions of their contract involving the laying of water lines. The architect has accepted, and recommends that the request be approved.

c. TRANSFER OF FUNDS

At the meetings of September 23, 1968, and November 25, 1968, respectively, the Board of Trustees authorized a transfer of \$250,000 and \$150,000 from the Building Fund to the General Fund. The General Fund has now received about 67 percent of its property tax levy and will receive the balance of actual collections on May 29, 1969. There is an adequate balance from which the amount of \$250,000 may be transferred at this time back to the Building Fund. It is recommended that the attached Resolution be adopted.
