Board Agenda - March 27, 2023

On March 27, 2023, the South Orange County Community College District Board of Trustees met for a regularly scheduled meeting. The following are highlights from the meeting held at 6:30 p.m. in the Ronald Reagan Board Room.

- The meeting was presided by President Timothy Jemal who opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance led by Trustee T.J. Prendergast and the invocation led Trustee Marcia Milchiker. The invocation made mention of the spring season that represents renewal and restoration and paid homage to the lives lost from the mass shooting that occurred on March 27 in Nashville, Tennessee.
