### 1. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

# a. TRUSTEE AREAS

A special committee composed of Mr. Vogel and Mr. Lund will make a report and a recommendation concerning trustee areas and Board membership.

#### b. FEDERAL ASSISTANCE

It is recommended that the Superintendent/President be authorized to apply for Federal funds amounting to \$350,000 to aid in the construction of the Science-Mathematics building and to apply for funds amounting to \$15,000 for Science-Mathematics Equipment.
