The Regular Meeting of the Governing Board of the Saddleback Community College District was held in the Board Room at 28000 Marguerite Parkway, Mission Viejo, California, Monday, May 10, 1971, at 7:45 P.M.

Motion by Mr. Collins, duly seconded and unanimously carried, MINUTES OF to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on April 26, 4-26-71 1971, as presented. APPROVED

Dr. Bremer distributed copies of the Statement of Votes Cast and Certificate of Election Results for the Governing Board Election on April 20, 1971, and miscellaneous communication items to the Board of Trustees.

Dr. Bremer informed the Members of the Board that the Annual Business Meeting of the Orange County School Boards Association will be held on Friday, May 21, at 6:30 P.M., at the Newporter Inn, Newport Beach, with Mr. Ray Bradbury as speaker; and that a Workshop for School Board Members will be held on Saturday, May 22, at 9:00 A.M., at the Mission Viejo High School, Mission Viejo, with Senator Carpenter as speaker.

Dr. Bremer stated that he had received a report indicating that the COST-OF-LIVING cost-of-living index for the Los Angeles Area from March, 1970, INDEX REPORT to March, 1971, is 4.0. He explained that the certificated salary schedule is based on the cost-of-living index, and that meetings with regard to salaries will be held in the near future. Mr. Barletta reported that the Pacific Fire Rating Bureau had recently conducted a survey with regard to fire insurance coverage. He explained that, as a result of that survey, the Northwestern Mutual Insurance Company had billed the District for an additional annual amount of \$3,238. He further explained that the premium adjustment was retroactive to October 28, 1969, effective date of the policy.

Mr. Barletta recommended that payment in the amount of \$6,476 be authorized to the Northwestern Mutual Insurance Company for the additional annual premium retroactive to October 28, 1969.

The Members of the Board and the Administration discussed the above in detail.

Motion by Mr. Collins, duly seconded and unanimously carried, to authorize payment in the amount of \$6,476 to Northwestern Mutual Insurance Company, such payment to be contingent on approval of County Counsel after a review of the District's policy.

Motion by Mr. Collins, duly seconded and unanimously carried, that Purchase Orders 6767 through 6836, totaling \$5,124.86, be approved and that payment be authorized upon delivery and acceptance of the items ordered.

Motion by Mr. Brannon, duly seconded and unanimously carried, that District Warrants 96-7534 through 96-7657, totaling \$34,418.74, be approved and ratified for payment.

Dr. Bremer presented Legislative Report Number 6 to the Members of the Board for their information.

Mr. Vogel adjourned the Regular Meeting into Executive Session at 8:10 P.M.
