

## DELINEATION OF FUNCTIONS AGREEMENT – NON-CREDIT ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The District is authorized to offer non-credit adult education courses by mutual agreement with the appropriate high school and/or unified school district. The courses allowed include those leading to a high school diploma; vocational or occupational training and/or retraining; parent education, consumer education, civic education, and education in the arts and humanities.

The mutual agreements shall be approved by the Board and forwarded to the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office.

The Chancellor shall establish regulations for review and approval of mutual agreements between the District and other local educational agencies.
