Barletta, Assistant Superintendent -**Business Services** ABSENT Absent: Miss Nanci Ormasa, Student Member A motion was made by Trustee McKnight, seconded AGENDA ADOPTED by Trustee Walther, and carried to adopt the agenda with a minor word change. The recommendations concerning Board Report Numbers 777 and 778 were revised from "approval" to "consideration and/or approval." The Clerk of the Board of Trustees reported the ACTION TAKEN action taken during Executive Session on June 11, DURING 1979, as follows: EXECUTIVE SESSION ON A motion was made by Trustee Watts, seconded by JUNE 11, 1979 Trustee Brandt, and unanimously carried that the Board of Trustees consider the need to upgrade the present district insurance coverage on property and liability risks; review the spreadsheets used by the present broker in obtaining premium quotations from insurance companies, past and present; and request the present broker to submit a statement of commissions received since serving the district.

A motion was made by Trustee Watts, seconded by Trustee Walther, and carried to enter into negotiations for an interdistrict tuition agreement which will require student permits from the district of residence to the district of attendance and which will further provide payment to the district of attendance of state apportionment only.

Trustee Brandt voted no.

A motion was made by Trustee Watts, seconded by Trustee Connolly, and unanimously carried to approve the action taken during executive session on June 11, 1979, as reported.

The Trustees engaged in open discussion concerning its intention to consider proposals for the expansion of the bookstore facilities and operation, including also other facilities of student services.

A motion was made by Trustee Taylor, seconded by Trustee Walther, and unanimously carried to invite proposals to construct, on district property, a student activities complex including, but not limited to, a bookstore, food services, and a student center offering the following: counseling and guidance, a special services/women's center, a career center, extended opportunity programs and services, financial aids, associated student body/student activities, a student health center, a veterans' affairs office, an employment development department, a career placement office and work experience.

The Trustees engaged in open discussion concerning its intention to consider proposals under the provision of Education Code Section 81390 to develop the district's property along Marguerite Parkway.

A motion was made by Trustee Watts, seconded by Trustee Taylor, and unanimously carried that the administration actively pursue inviting proposals for the development of the land along Marguerite Parkway.

Trustee Price requested that Trustee Connolly offer his attention to the matters dealing with the development of the property along Marguerite Parkway. He also requested that Trustee Watts offer his attention to the matters of the student activities complex. ACTION TAKEN DURING EXECUTIVE SESSION ON JUNE 11, 1979
