2. <u>GRANT APPLICATIONS: IRVINE VALLEY COLLEGE</u> <u>AND SADDLEBACK COLLEGE</u>

ACTION

It is recommended that the board approve the following grant applications.

a. <u>DEVELOPMENT OF COURSE PREDICTION MODELS:</u> <u>IRVINE VALLEY COLLEGE AND SADDLEBACK</u> <u>COLLEGE.</u>

This project's purpose is to develop profiles of student factors which predict success, failure, and withdrawal from courses. Objectives include: 1) multiple measures to supplement the assessment and advisement component of matriculation, 2) understanding of the basic skill levels students must possess to succeed in entry level, general education courses, and 3) sophistication in stepwise, multiple logistics regression.

b. <u>EARLY ALERT: A RESEARCH PILOT PROJECT:</u> <u>IRVINE VALLEY COLLEGE</u>

The purpose of this project is to design, implement, and evaluate an early alert program. Objectives include 1) early alert software development, 2) high level of faculty participation, 3) development of a tutoring pool, and 4) a thorough evaluation of the program and the effectiveness of early alert.

c. <u>REVISION AND STANDARDIZATION OF THE</u> <u>EDUCATIONAL PLANNING COMPONENT OF</u> <u>MATRICULATION: IRVINE VALLEY COLLEGE</u>

The purpose of this proposal represents an effort to improve an existing program within the college that addresses the educational planning component of Matriculation to ensure that students successfully complete their education including certification programs, graduation, and transfer. The finished product of curriculum and handbook would be available to other community colleges in the state.

3. <u>IRVINE VALLEY COLLEGE: 1989-1990 ADDITIONAL</u> <u>ACTION</u> <u>COURSE INSTRUCTIONAL FEES</u>

It is recommended that the board approve Irvine Valley College's additional and revised instruction fees for 1989-1990, effective summer 1990, as presented in the agenda exhibit.

b. <u>CHANGE ORDER NO. 6: STUDENT SERVICES CENTER:</u> SADDLEBACK COLLEGE

It is recommended that the board ratify Change Order No. 8 to amend the contract with Culp Construction Company for construction of the Student Services Center by increasing the contract amount to \$6,979,375.16, and to extend the time of completion to April 10, 1990.

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c. <u>CHANGE ORDER NO. 7: TECHNOLOGY/APPLIED</u> SCIENCES BUILDING: SADDLEBACK COLLEGE

It is recommended that the board ratify Change Order No. 7 to amend the contract with Construction Incorporated of Texas for construction of the Technology/Applied Science Building by increasing the contract amount by \$131,217.

7. ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT PROCEEDS: TECHNOLOGY/APPLIED SCIENCE BUILDING: SADDLEBACK COLLEGE

It is recommended that the board approve a consultant agreement with LeRoy Crandall and Associates to provide soils tests for a thermal energy storage tank at a cost not to exceed \$3.500.
