

CHANCELLOR SUCCESSION

I. ACTING CHANCELLOR

The Board delegates authority to the Chancellor to appoint an acting Chancellor to serve in their absence for short periods of time, not to exceed 30 calendar days at a time.

In the absence of the Chancellor and when an acting Chancellor has not been named, administrative responsibility shall reside with the Vice Chancellor, Business Services.

The Board shall appoint an acting Chancellor for periods exceeding 30 calendar days due to the Chancellor's absence.

II. INTERIM CHANCELLOR

In the event that the Chancellor position is vacant, the Board may appoint an interim Chancellor until a regular appointment is made. Appointment of an Interim Chancellor may not exceed two years.
