*WHEREAS*, Lunar New Year is often referred to as Spring Festival in various Asian countries; and

*WHEREAS*, many religious and ethnic communities use lunar-based calendars; and

*WHEREAS*, Lunar New Year began in China more than 4,000 years ago and is widely celebrated in East and Southeast Asia; and

*WHEREAS*, the Asian diaspora has expanded the Lunar New Year celebration into an annual worldwide event; and

*WHEREAS*, Lunar New Year is celebrated with community activities and cultural performances; and

*WHEREAS*, participants celebrating Lunar New Year travel to spend the holiday reuniting with family and friends; and

*WHEREAS*, Lunar New Year is traditionally a time to wish upon others good fortune, health, prosperity, and happiness; and

*WHEREAS*, Lunar New Year is celebrated by thousands of Asian American students, staff and faculty at Irvine Valley College and Saddleback College and by many non-Asian Americans throughout the District; and, now, therefore,


**BE IT RESOLVED** that the South Orange County Community College District (SOCCCD) recognizes the cultural and historical significance of Lunar New Year; and






