On Monday August 25, 2025, the South Orange County Community College District Board of Trustees met for a regularly scheduled meeting. The following are highlights from the meeting held at 6:30 p.m. in the Ronald Reagan Board Room.

### 5.0 Public Hearings

#### 5,2 Adopted Budget for Fiscal Year 2025-2026

The proposed Adopted Budget comprises 16 funds totaling \$995.1 million in budgeted expenditures, which includes the Associated Student Government and Student Representation Fee funds along with the EPA revenue. The two largest funds are the General Fund with \$551.1 million in budgeted expenditures and the Capital Outlay Fund with \$368.9 million in budgeted expenditures representing 55 percent and 37 percent of the total District-wide expenditures, respectively. The General Fund includes an unrestricted and restricted component with the unrestricted component being considered the operating fund for the District.

A resolution to recognize Women's Equality Day as a national day celebrating the importance of the women's suffrage movement and the work to secure and expand equal rights today.
