Whereas, the South Orange County Community College District (SOCCCD), comprised of Irvine Valley College and Saddleback College, is committed to providing an open and welcoming environment for all students; and

Whereas, the California Community College system enrolls the largest population of undocumented students of any segment of public higher education; and

Whereas, when undocumented immigrants can pursue their career and professional goals free of institutional barriers and discrimination, they are able to reach their educational goals and, in turn, contribute to the improvement of their communities and our economy; and

Whereas, the California Community Colleges hosts an annual Undocumented Student Action Week (USAW) every third week of October; and

Whereas, SOCCCD joins numerous community colleges in California with an adoption of policies and procedures consistent with protecting immigrant students, and creating partnerships with community organizations to help our undocumented students access legal assistance and other services in our community; and




Whereas, SOCCCD stands united as a district where all students can learn, grow, and feel supported and safe; now, therefore,




