6.1 SOCCCD: Resolution in Recognition of the 40th Anniversary of Irvine Valley College

A resolution recognizing and celebrating the 40th anniversary of Irvine Valley College for its outstanding contributions to student success, academic excellence, workforce development, and community impact. **APPROVED** 

## 6.2 SOCCCD: Resolution - Filipino American History Month

The celebration of Filipino American History Month (FANHS) in October commemorates the first recorded presence of Filipinos in the continental United States, which occurred on October 18, 1587, when "Luzones Indios" came ashore from the Spanish galleon Nuestra Senora de Esperanza and landed at what is now Morro Bay, California.

In 2009, U.S. Congress recognized October as Filipino American History Month in the United States. Various states, counties, and cities in the U.S. have established proclamations and resolutions declaring observance of Filipino American History Month. The late Dr. Fred Cordova, along with his wife, FANHS Founder Dr. Dorothy Laigo Cordova, first introduced October as Filipino American History Month in 1992 with a resolution from the FANHS National Board of Trustees.

Across the nation, FANHS Chapters, colleges and universities, museums, and community groups will be commemorating Filipino American History Month with various activities and events to bring awareness of the significant role Filipinos have played in American history. **APPROVED** 

#### 6.3 SOCCCD: Resolution Recognizing Invisible Disabilities Week

Invisible Disabilities Week is observed nationally in October to bring awareness and understanding to the challenges faced by individuals whose disabilities may not be immediately apparent, including but not limited to chronic illnesses, neurological differences, mental health conditions, and other impairments. **APPROVED**

## 7.1 SOCCCD: Rescission of Grant Agreement with Compass Energy

At the meeting of the Board of Trustees on September 29, 2025, the Board considered a request from the City of San Juan Capistrano to rescind the Grant Agreement between the District and Compass Energy (agenda item 14.1). Following presentations from the City of San Juan Capistrano and the Project Applicant, the Board approved a motion for staff to draft findings justifying termination of the grant agreement to be approved at the next regular board meeting. **APPROVED**
