[6.1 SOCCCD: Resolution - Recognizing and Honoring Black History Month Trustee Black](#)

History Month is an annual celebration of achievements by African Americans and a time for recognizing their central role in U.S. history. Also known as African American History Month, the event grew out of "Negro History Week," the brainchild of noted historian Carter G. Woodson and other prominent African Americans. Since 1976, every U.S. president has officially designated the month of February as Black History Month. Other countries around the world, including Canada and the United Kingdom, also devote a month to celebrating Black history. **APPROVED**

Recognizing the cultural and historical significance of Lunar New Year in 2026, a time to unify family, celebrate one's cultural heritage and past, and welcome new opportunities. Background: California Education Code Section 84040 requires that an annual audit of all District funds be made by a Certified Public Accountant or a Public Accountant licensed by the California Board of Accountancy. Title 5, California Code of Regulations, Section 59104, further requires that the governing board of each community college district review the annual audit at a regularly scheduled public meeting.

Recommendation: The Chancellor recommends that the Board of Trustees accepts the District, the ATEP Facilities Corporation, the Irvine Valley College Foundation, the Saddleback College Foundation, and the Foundation for South Orange County Community College District FY 2024-25 audit/review reports as presented. **APPROVED**
