

## SELECTION OF LIBRARY MATERIALS

The libraries are an integral component of the colleges and their instructional programs. The libraries provide informational and research support for campus-wide curriculum. The Board charges the library faculty with the responsibility for developing the libraries' collections. This includes the selection of appropriate library materials and the continued evaluation and maintenance of the collections. To this end, library faculty and staff work in concert with instructional faculty to select material that is comprehensive, accurate, diverse, current, and highly accessible through the best use of acquisition, cataloging, and processing techniques.

The Chancellor shall ensure that the colleges and their library staff maintain compliance with all applicable state and federal laws related to library operations, including the Reader Privacy Act.
