

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION 3530

GENERAL INSTITUTION

WEAPONS ON CAMPUS

Firearms, knives, stun guns, explosives, or other dangerous objects prohibited by law, including but not limited to any replica/likeness of a firearm, knife, or explosive, are prohibited on any District premises (owned, leased, or rented). The prohibition of firearms on any District premises includes both loaded and unloaded firearms and applies to persons holding a valid license to carry a concealed firearm.

Activities involving firearms or other weapons, to include replicas, conducted under the direction of a District-designated official shall be reported and approved by the Chief of Police of the respective college campus before taking place.

Any person except law enforcement officials who believes they may properly possess a firearm or other weapon on District premises shall promptly notify and obtain written permission from the Chief of Police of the respective college campus.

It is prohibited to bring or possess any dirk, dagger, ice pick, or knife with a fixed blade longer than 2 ½ inches on District premises. The only exception would be for District employees, students, or contractors who are authorized to possess such weapons in the course of their employment and/or instructional class activity, or persons authorized by the Chief of Police to have such a weapon. Any person who is authorized to have a knife, including kitchen knives, must exercise caution in using and storing them.
